Notice is given that a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts as set out in Section 26 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act. - under section 27 of the Local Authority and Accountability Act 2014 apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law
