Changes for the provision of cycle hangars, dockless cycle and e-scooter hire parking places and junction protection

The Camden (Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No.) Order 202*

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Camden proposes to make the above Order under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general nature and effect of the Order would be to:
 - (a) remove certain lengths of permit holders parking space and provide single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install pedal cycle hangars at the following locations (lengths of parking space to be removed given in brackets, below):
 - (i) in **Belsize Avenue** (zone CA-B), on the north-west side, outside Nos. 21 and 23 Belsize Avenue (5.6 metres);
 - (ii) in **Belsize Road** (zone CA-K/R), on the south-east side, opposite Nos. 110 and 112 Belsize Road (5.6 metres);
 - (iii) in **Burghley Road** (zone CA-M), on the south-east side, at the side of No. 86 Burghley Road (5.6 metres);
 - (iv) in **College Place** (zone CA-G/F), on the north-east side, outside Plender Court (5.6 metres);
 - (v) in **Countess Road** (zone CA-M), on the north side, at the side of No. 44 Montpelier Grove (5.6 metres);

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- (xiii) in **Goldhurst Terrace** (zone CA-R/K), on the north-west side, opposite No. 123 Goldhurst Terrace (5.6 metres);
- (xiv) in **Hemstal Road** (zone CA-R/Q), on the north side, outside Nos. 32 and 34 Hemstal Road (5.6 metres);
- (xv) in **Hillfield Road** (zone CA-P), on the north-west side, opposite 44-49 Cholmley Gardens (5.6 metres);
- (xvi) in **Iverson Road** (zone CA-Q), (1) on the south side, outside No. 206 Iverson Road (5.6 metres); and (2) on the south-east side, outside Nos. 32 and 34 Iverson Road (5.6 metres);

- (b) in **Belsize Terrace**, on the south-west side, at the side of No. 18 Belsize Park, remove the north-westernmost 9.6 metres of existing zone 'B' permit parking place and replace it with single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install (i) cycle hangars (5.6 metres) and (ii) cycle stands (4 metres);
- (c) in **Broadhurst Gardens**, on the south-west side, remove the existing zone 'B' permit parking place outside Nos. 5 to 9 Broadhurst Gardens and replace it with (i) a 5.6-metre extension of the existing dockless cycle hire and e-scooter parking place; and (ii) 5.6 metres of single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars;
- (d) in Canfield Gardens, on the north-west side, (i) remove the existing disabled parking place outside Nos. 24 and 26 Canfield Gardens and replace it with zone 'R' permit parking place; and (ii) outside Nos. 20 and 22 Canfield Gardens, remove 5.6 metres of zone 'R' permit parking place and replace it with single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars;
- (e) in **Dunollie Road**, (i) at its junction with Lady Margaret Road, remove a total of 11 metres of zone 'M' permit parking place, to extend the existing double yellow lines by 5.9 metres on the north side and 5.1 metres on the south side; (ii) at its junction with Montpelier Grove, remove a total of 10.4 metres of zone 'M' permit parking place, to extend the existing double yellow lines by 4.4 metres on the north side and 6.0 metres on the south side; (iii) remove 5.6 metres of zone 'M' permit parking place and provide single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install pedal cycle hangars (1) on the north side, at the side of No. 36 Montpelier Grove; and (2) on the south side, at the side of 22c Lady Margaret Road;
- (f) in **Falkland Road**, (i) on the south side, outside No. 64 Falkland Road, remove 5.6 metres of existing zone 'M' permit parking place and replace it with single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars; (ii) at its junctions with Montpelier Grove and Willingham Terrace, remove all the single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions; (iii) remove lengths of zone 'M' permit parking place and replace them with double yellow lines (1) on the north side, outside Nos. 69 and 71 Falkland Road (5.6 metres); (2) on the north side, outside Nos. 73 and 75 Falkland Road (3.9 metres); and (3) on the south side, outside No. 70 Falkland Road (4.8 metres);

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- (g) in **Fordwych Road**, (i) on the north-east side, outside Nos. 217 and 219 Fordwych Road remove 5.6 metres of existing zone 'Q' permit parking place and replace it with single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars; (ii) on the south-west side, outside Nos. 108 and 110 Fordwych Road remove 5.6 metres of existing zone 'Q' permit parking place and replace it with single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars; and (iii) on the south-west side, outside No. 114 Fordwych Road, remove the existing dedicated disabled parking place and replace it with an extension of the existing zone 'Q' permit holders parking place;
- (h) in **Grafton Terrace**, on the south side, remove lengths of zone 'L' permit parking place and replace them with double yellow lines (1) outside No. 39 Grafton Terrace (1.7 metres); and (2) outside No. 37 Grafton Terrace (3.6 metres);
- (i) in **Lady Margaret Road**, on the east side, outside Nos. 22b and 22c, extend the existing double yellow lines by 4.1 metres;
- (j) in **Lawford Road**, on the north side, (i) outside Nos. 33 and 35 Lawford Road, remove 5.2 metres of zone 'M' permit parking place and replace it with single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars; and (ii) at the side of No. 66 Bartholomew Road, remove the easternmost 6.0 metres of zone 'M' permit parking place and replace it with single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install a cargo bike hangar unit;
- (k) in **Leighton Grove**, (i) on the south-east side, opposite Nos. 8 to 10 Leighton Grove, remove 10.4 metres of existing zone 'M' permit holders parking place and replace it with (1) a 4.8-metre extension of the existing dockless cycle and e-scooter hire parking place; and (2) 5.6 metres of single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars; and (ii) replace all the existing single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions that lie between its junction with Leighton Road and No. 7 Leighton Grove with double yellow lines;
- (I) in **Lyndhurst Road**, on the north-west side, outside No. 11a Lyndhurst Road, remove the existing dedicated disabled parking place and replace it with an extension of the existing zone 'H' permit holders parking place;
- (m) in **Montpelier Grove**, (i) at its junction with Ospringe Road, (1) replace all the existing single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions with double yellow lines; (2) on the west side, at the side of No. 1 Ospringe Road, remove the northernmost 4 metres of existing zone 'M' permit holders parking place and replace it with double yellow lines; and (3) on the east side, opposite the side of No. 1 Ospringe Road, remove the northernmost 5-metre zone 'M' permit holders parking place and replace it with a 3-metre length of single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars and a 2-metre length of double yellow lines; (ii) around its junction with Dunollie Road, extend the existing double yellow lines by a total of 10.3 metres by removing (1) 6.5 metres of zone 'M' permit parking place outside No. 36 Montpelier Grove; (2) 3.8 metres of zone 'M' permit parking place outside No. 35 Montpelier Grove; and (iii) at its junction with Falkland Road, (1) replace all the existing single

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- yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions with double yellow lines; and (2) on the east side, at the side of No. 73 Falkland Road, remove the southernmost 3.6 metres of existing zone 'M' permit holders parking place and replace it with double yellow lines;
- (n) in **Ospringe Road**, (i) on the north side, opposite No. 29 Ospringe Road, remove 3.0 metres of zone 'M' permit parking place and replace it with single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars; (ii) on the south side, around its junction with Montpelier Grove, replace all the existing single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions with double yellow lines; and (iii) on the south and south-east sides, remove lengths of zone 'M' permit parking place and replace them with double yellow lines (1) opposite No. 2b Ospringe Road (6.4 metres); and (2) outside No. 1 Ospringe Road (4 metres);
- (o) in **Thurlow Terrace**, on the west side, at the side of No. 39 Grafton Terrace, remove the northernmost 7.1 metres of zone 'L' permit holder parking place and replace it with (i) a 1.5-metre extension of the existing double yellow lines and (ii) a 5.6-metre length of single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars;
- (p) in **Torriano Avenue**, on the north-west side, outside Nos. 133 and 135 Torriano Avenue, remove 10.6 metres of existing zone 'M' permit parking place and replace it with (i) a 5-metre extension of the existing dockless cycle and e-scooter hire parking place; and (ii) a 5.6-metre length of single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install cycle hangars;
- (q) in **Tottenham Street**, on the south-east side, outside No. 21 Tottenham Street, remove the north-easternmost 4.6 metres of existing zone 'E' resident permit parking place and replace it with single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install (i) a cycle hangars; and (ii) a traffic island;
- (r) in **Willingham Terrace**, on both sides, replace the 10 metres of single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions closest to its junction with Falkland Road with double yellow lines.

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Statement of reasons

On-street changes for the provision of cycle hangars, dockless cycle and e-scooter hire parking places and junction protection

The proposals aim to introduce secure cycle hangars which provide covered, secure, and fully enclosed cycle storage facilities at 59 locations across the Borough. There is an ever increasing demand for such facilities from residents living in high density dwellings with limited space for sheltered and secure cycle storage space within their properties. A lack of secure cycle hangar storage facilities is currently a barrier to some of our residents cycling. The introduction of secure cycle hangar storage facilities, especially in locations near high density dwellings, would encourage more of our residents to cycle.

The proposals include the provision of a cargo bike hangar at 1 of the 59 locations (Lawford Road). This would fully accommodate 2 cargo bikes. It would be available for residents to store cargo bikes only.

The proposals include the provision of 3 cycle parking stands alongside new cycle hangars at 1 of the 59 locations (Belsize Terrace). These stands would provide short stay cycle parking facilities for visitors. Cycle hangars provide long stay cycle parking facilities for residents.

The proposals include extensions to existing E-Scooter & Cycle Hire parking bays at 3 sites and the removal of redundant disabled parking bays at 5 sites.

The proposals include the introduction of double yellow lines at 5 locations to improve road safety at junctions in accordance with Camden's junction protection programme.

The proposals also include the planting of a tree on a small island alongside a new cycle hangar at 1 of the 59 locations (Tottenham Street).

Enabling cycling is a key strategic outcome for the Council as set out in multiple strategy documents. The <u>Camden Transport Strategy</u> (CTS), adopted in 2019, has 7 objectives, 4 of which are directly aligned with the proposals for this scheme (objectives 1, 2, 3, and 6). The proposed scheme also aligns with the CTS delivery plan for 2022/2023 to 2024/2025, <u>here</u>.

The <u>Camden Transport Strategy</u> (CTS) and accompanying <u>Cycling Action Plan</u> aim to transform transport and mobility in Camden, enabling and encouraging people to travel, and goods to be transported, healthily and sustainably. The CTS sets our objectives, policies, and measures for achieving this goal. Our priorities include:

- increasing walking and cycling
- improving public transport in the borough

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- reducing car ownership and use
- improving the quality of our air
- making our streets and transport networks safe, accessible, and inclusive for all

The proposals meet the objectives of the Camden Transport Strategy (CTS) by:

- helping to facilitate an increase in cycling.
- reducing the dominance of motor vehicles.
- helping to facilitate improving the quality of our air.
- making our streets and transport networks safe, accessible, and inclusive for all.

The proposals meet the objectives of <u>We Make Camden</u> by helping create clean, vibrant, and sustainable places and making it easier for people to travel by active modes of transport, which would help to encourage residents and visitors to cycle more instead of driving motor vehicles or using public transport. This would in turn contribute to improving air quality and lowering carbon emissions in the borough. The proposals also meet the objectives of We Make Camden by responding to the impacts of climate change.

The Council of the London Borough of Camden, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Camden (Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 202* and shall come into force on ** **** 202*.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order:

"Council" means the Council of the London Borough of Camden;

"map based schedule" means a map tile attached to this Order and listed in the Schedule to this Order which depicts the parking places designated by the Order of 2025 and, in conjunction with either the map schedule legend or a map tile label, or both, identifies the type of each particular parking place and, where specified, certain of its governing provisions:

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for any inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the map based schedule and where a parking place is depicted in the map based schedule, that parking place will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data;

"map schedule legend" means the map schedule legend attached to the Order of 2025 which, when used in conjunction with a map tile, identifies the specific type of parking place designated by the Order of 2025 and, where specified, certain of its governing provisions;

"map tile" means an individual map with a specific tile reference, being part of the map based schedule attached to this Order;

- "the Order of 2025" means the Camden (Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2025².
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any other Order or enactment shall be construed as a reference to that Order or enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by, or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent Order or enactment:
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2025 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Substitution of map tiles

- 3. (1) Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2025 shall have effect as though for the map tiles attached to that Order there were substituted the map tiles similarly referenced and attached to this Order.
 - (2) The substitution of any map tile referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article will have the effect of revoking or omitting any provision designated or imposed or applied by a previous version of that map tile and not incorporated into the latest version.

Designation of parking places or loading places and application of the Order of 2025 thereto

- 4. (1) Each area on a street identified in a map tile as a parking place or loading place and, where applicable, by way of the map schedule legend as an area marked out or signed for the use therein of specified classes of vehicles following the conditions specified in the Order of 2025 in relation to that type of parking place or loading place, as the case may be, is designated as a parking place or a loading place.
 - (2) Unless otherwise so identified, a parking place or loading place shall be bounded on one side of its length by the edge of the carriageway and be an area marked either by a traffic sign or by another method of indicating the extent of a parking place as specified in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016³.
 - (3) The provisions of the Order of 2025 shall apply to an area designated as a parking place or loading place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place or loading place, as the case may be, included a reference to an area designated as a parking place or loading place by this Order.

Waiting restrictions, loading restrictions and stopping restrictions and application of the Order of 2025 thereto

- 5. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2025 shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) any waiting restriction or loading restriction identified in a map tile and, where applicable, by way of either a map tile label or the map schedule legend, or both, and marked out or signed as a waiting restriction or a loading restriction shall be construed as through it were a restricted street referred to in the Order of 2025; and
 - (b) any stopping restriction identified in a map tile and, where applicable, by way of either a map tile label or the map schedule legend, or both, and marked out or signed as a stopping restriction shall be construed as through it were a stopping restriction referred to in the Order of 2025.

Placing of Traffic Signs, etc

- 6. The Council shall:
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs or other appropriate markings on the surface of the street indicating the limits of each parking place or loading designated by, or each length of waiting or loading or stopping restrictions imposed by, this Order; and
 - (b) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of such parking place, loading place, or length of waiting or loading or stopping restrictions.
