• 9 people are in Supported Living



• 9 people get Community Support



 12 people are not in Supported Living and do not get Community Support

Why do people not go to activities? Transport



7 people said they do not go because of transport



 6 people said when transport is too crowded it makes them scared and anxious



• 2 people said sometimes there is no room for their wheelchairs

Why can't people go to activities? Appointments



5 people said they do not go when they have appointments



 2 people said they do not pick when their appointment is and go when the GP or hospital tells them to



 3 people said they need support with their appointments so go when the staff is available even if it is during an activity

Why can't people not go to activities? Feeling Unwell



8 people said they do not go when they feel unwell



People said that when they are sick they do not go to activities



 5 people said when they are feeling upset or anxious they do not go to activities

Why can't people go to activities? Support



5 people do not go because they do not have the support



• 3 people said they have limited support hours and need to do other things when they get support, such as do chores



 2 people said that sometimes their service does not have enough staff so they cannot go to an activity



 2 people said that they do not go if their friends are not going because they do not like to go alone

Why can't people go to activities? Other Reasons



7 people can't go to activities because they cannot find childcare



6 people said that cannot go to paid activities because they do not have the money
