- Children and Young People Disability Service (CYPDS)



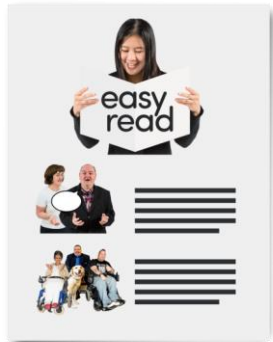
These were also sent by email to all people who attend Planning Together
